Under creative writing, for school kids a 'story writing' competition was held where students were asked to choose a topic from the given list - 'the bridge' (pool), 'whole night rain' (*saari raat barish*), 'One day at School (*ek din school mein*)'. For college going ones, a triathlon in creative writing was conducted where participants were asked to write a story, poem and a paragraph on one of the given topics ['a dependent independence (*a nirvarshil swatantrata*)', 'illogical (*ayotik*)', and 'palanquins (*doli/ palki*)']. In creative speaking, children were asked to pick a topic from the given three topics - "I am proud to be an Indian", or "village life is better" or "Mumbai should be free from slum" and to speak both 'for' and 'against' of the same. "Monsoon" was the theme for the creative painting and kids of primary level were asked to paint on national symbols - like flag, animal and flower.

One of the most interesting events on the occasion was the craft session. Children prepared creative designs from color papers, ice cream sticks, straws etc.

The program ended with prize distribution and words of encouragement.

Sumit Agarwal has to say the following: 'The energy and enthusiasm of children makes you feel like a child again. When we are leaving from the place after the session kids screamed together - 'do come again'... What can be more satisfying than this!!!
